1. Performed hand hygiene.				
2. Provided for patient privacy.				
3. Introduced self to patient and family.				
4. Verified health care provider's orders.				
5. Identified patient using two identifiers, compared these with information on patient's ID bracelet.				
6. Gathered necessary equipment and supplies.				
7. Raised bed to comfortable working height, lowered side rail on your side.				
8. Assisted patient to appropriate position, draped bath blanket over patient.				
9. Applied gloves, prepared urinary drainage collection bag and tubing, clamped off drainage bag port, placed drainage bag nearby.				
10. Performed perineal care after draping patient, assessed penis for rashes or skin breakdown, dried penis thoroughly, dried penis, returned foreskin to normal position if applicable, did not apply barrier cream, applied skin preparation and hair guard if present.				
11. Clipped patient's hair at base of penis if necessary and allowed.				
12. Held penis and catheter properly, rolled sheath smoothly onto penis, allowed space between the tip and end of condom catheter. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. Secured condom catheter as indicated in manufacturer's guidelines. b. Spiral wrapped penile shaft with elastic adhesive if applicable. c. Ensured toilet paper was within reach, instructed patient on how to properly wipe. 				
13. Secured tubing properly to patient's leg or abdomen, removed hair guard, connected drainage tubing to end of condom catheter, secured tubing to inner thigh with slack, secured any excess tubing to bottom sheet of linen.				

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| 14. Attached one end of tubing to catheter and other to leg bag if appropriate, attached bag to patient's leg with straps. | | | | |
| 15. Helped patient into safe, comfortable position, lowered bed, adjusted side rails for safety. Ensured bed wheels were locked. | | | | |
| 16. Disposed of all contaminated supplies, removed gloves, performed hand hygiene. | | | | |
| 17. Placed personal items within reach. | | | | |
| 18. Ensured patient knew how to use call light. | | | | |
| 19. Assessed penis within 15 to 30 minutes of application of catheter, checked for swelling and discoloration, asked if patient is experiencing discomfort. | | | | |
